It has come to the attention of this committee that the neighboring town of South Shaftsbury is attempting to raise funds in order to provide a much needed Health Clinic, to serve it and other nearby communities, including North Bennington. We feel that a contribution from the college towards this objective is to be highly recommended. Not only is the cause in itself worthy, but there is also the added factor that Dr. McCullough was one of the instigators of this movement and was interested in both the establishment of a clinic and in its subsequent maintenance. Therefore we propose to raise a college fund, separate from the Spring Charity Drive, which will be turned over in the name of Dr. McCullough to the town of South Shaftsbury for such a clinic.

This fund will consist of voluntary contributions from the members of the community who feel they want to subscribe to this fund. The student collectors will instigate a discussion of this matter in house meeting within the near future and they will collect such funds as may be volunteered.
