Memorandum concerning Definition IV of the College Standards.

Interpretation passed by the Community Council, October 15th.

The Standard Read: "Any individual who wishes to engage in any activity off ~~of~~ the campus, such as surveys or organizing, must first consult her counselor. Any group must notify the Community Council that it plans to engage in any such activity."

The interpretation submitted and passed is: "Both to simplify the public relations of the college and to allow freedom to the individual, it is understood that the counselor and the Community Council, (or the student directly, if immediate action is necessary) will report any off-campus activity that is of a controversial nature to the President."
