

Report of Recreation Council Meeting -- October 21, 1940.

At the Recreation Council Meeting of October 21st, the Entertainment Committee announced the plan for serving beer at the election party without selling it. They will sell refreshment tickets which will be for hot dogs and beer or doughnuts and cider. They have not yet decided on the price for the tickets.

The Council discussed the problem of lack of interest and cooperation in hockey on the part of those who signed up to play. At the beginning of the season there were about twenty people signed up to play each day, but only five or six report regularly for practice except on days when an outside game is scheduled. The Council has decided to investigate the problem <sup>and will</sup> attempt to get to the bottom of the difficulty. They will try to find out if classes interfere; if another time of day would be more desirable; if there is enough real interest remaining or if people prefer other types of recreation in the place of hockey.
