

Report Of Recreation Council Meeting - November 4, 1940.

In a previous meeting of the Recreation Council the possibility of having Mr. DeGrey give a series of concerts was discussed. However, after talking this over with him, it was decided to wait until next Spring when there will be more time to have a complete series.

Several people have signed up for shooting and the Recreation Council will get definite information about the laws and will find out if Mr. Perry or Jonny Wood can supervise it so it can be started at once.

There was also another discussion about fencing. It was reported that Arija Muray, a student, is qualified to teach the sport. Mr. Park is also interested and has offered to help. If there is sufficient interest in the community they will get together and arrange a class.

It will begin with a bonfire behind the stone wall and from there the procession will go to the Carriage Barn led by Mr. Nash and his trombone. The returns will be announced by Mr. Leigh and Mr. Truman every half hour and there will be entertainment in between the announcements. Cider and doughnuts will be sold for 10¢ and beer will be free with 35¢ hotdogs.
