

Report Of Recreation Council Meeting - November 11, 1940.

The Entertainment Committee reported that the election party was a great success. Refreshments were sold and beer was given away. The party paid for itself and there is a surplus. This money will be used for the Christmas party which is being planned by the Recreation Council. It was suggested that rum be included in the refreshments for the Christmas party. This would be a violation of the liquor policy but members of the Council recalled incidences of liquor being served at parties last Spring which were sponsored by divisions or committees. The representative from the Community Council suggested that this was probably before the liquor policy had been clearly defined. However, she will speak to members of the Central Committee and will report definitely at the next meeting.
