House Chairman Questionnaire

The Central Committee would like you to consider these questions and be prepared to discuss them with us.

I. The House Group

1. Is the house a unit? Does it work and play together? Does it discuss college problems and have a social life of its own?
2. Is there general co-operation in handling house duties?
3. Is there general compliance with the standards?
4. Is the house interested in its meetings? Do the members participate in discussion? Is the house constructive about community affairs?
5. Is there pressure of public opinion in the house against anyone neglecting the standards?

II. Individual problems

1. Is there any girl who is not assimilated by the group, or who refuses to mix with the group?
2. Are there cliques?
3. Does any girl continually disregard the standards?
 - a. Is there drinking to excess alone or in groups?
 - b. Has there been trouble with men in the living rooms? Student rooms?
4. Are there specific problems of personality adjustment?
5. Are there problems arising from room arrangement?
