It was felt that these girls had realized their mistake when Jeanne Gaudy spoke to them before the meeting and so no further action was taken.

The night policeman reported the following on March 13th. "Helene Ferris and another girl had four fellows in Jennings living room which arrived before 11 P.M. until 1:20 A.M. They took them to the student lounge at that time and one of the fellows went back to the house with Helene Ferris and stayed until 2:20 A.M. They were waiting for a fellow that had gone off with another girl and he did not arrive until 4:25 A.M. and went right back out and was coming back after the other fellows. The night policeman went to the student lounge and made the boy leave before he went off duty at 5 A.M. as the boys had been drinking." Jeanne Gaudy will speak to Helene about this and also find out more definitely whether the other girl mentioned in the report was from off campus.
