The following is an excerpt from the minutes of the last meeting of the General Meetings Committee, dealing with proposed re-organization.

"Proposals for Re-Organization

There was a considerable amount of discussion of possible re-organization of the Committee in line with the recent inter-committee conferences. It was agreed that:

- 1) the General Meetings Committee should be subordinate to the Community Council, in whatever form it takes, as the central planning body for the College;
- 2) it is important to have more faculty members on the Committee than are usually on student committees, because of their wider knowledge of people and names;
- 3) it is important to satisfy faculty as well as student demands and interests; (In particular it was recommended that divisions be informed of whatever action is taken by the Committee in regard to a speaker they proposed.)
- 4) the student EPC members should do a better job on representing their division's desires and interests to the Committee.

The suggested organization of the Committee was as follows:

- 1) an administrative officer (Miss Shelly) as chairman;
- 2) Mr. Belitt to continue to serve in charge of movies;
- 3) three other faculty members, appointed by the president; recommendations to be submitted by the retiring Committee;
- 4) two students, chosen by the Community Council from two slates submitted by the retiring Committee, one slate to contain students on the Recreation Council, the other students on the EPC. Student members to be chosen by the Council after the faculty members are appointed, so that there will be adequate representation of interests.

It was suggested that one member of the General Meetings Committee meet also with the Community Council.

The Committee felt very strongly that some re-organization was necessary to centralize the planning of general meetings, whether of a curricular or a recreational nature. "
