PRESENT: Pat Adams, Richard Haas, Joel Perlman, Stanley Rosen, Roger Williams, Isaac Witkin, Philip Wofford, Mary Barringer, and Nancy Sulkowski, secretary

1. Philip Wofford announced that George Sugarman would be arriving at 2:30 today to show slides in Barn 1. Isaac Witkin said that there is a fund already set up to pay the visiting artists. Philip Wofford will check with Mr. Kolkebeck about paying the artists from this fund.
2. Pat Adams suggested that Mr. Rappaport be asked to photograph the Mary Frank Exhibition and the exhibition of the Becker photos.
3. Mary Barringer asked if Jessica Jacobs, a teacher from UVM, could come to give a lecture or a workshop. The Division decided to have her send in some information regarding the proposed lecture before a decision is made and that May 16 might be set aside as a possible date.

Philip Wofford said that there was a letter from Donna Stein saying that she could give a lecture on May 23, entitled "Popular Mechanics in Printmaking."

4. Philip Wofford said that Brower Hatcher will be coming on Monday, May 8, for an interview.
5. Philip Wofford said that he spoke with Tim Smith who said that the sliding doors of the Ceramic Studio are not going to be painted and that he would be willing to discuss matters with the Division. Philip Wofford said that Mr. Ward has been invited to talk with the Division, but he has not yet replied.
6. The Division decided not to hold a meeting next week due to the beginning of long weekend.
7. The Division interviewed Robert Sabin as an applicant for the graduate program. After discussion, the Division choose Robert Sabin to fill the vacancy for a graduate student for next fall. Pat Adams suggested that Henry Chotkowski be encouraged to reapply. Roger Williams suggested that Henry Chotkowski might be offered a position tuition free but without the stipend.
8. Philip Wofford read a letter from Josephine Kerr saying that she had not been notified that she was to be reviewed in May and couldn't get her material together by May 10. The Division decided to give her an extension until May 24.
