Re: Exploding glassware

All water glasses and orange juice glasses of the Durit glassware were removed from the dining rooms Sunday night, October 18th. I have left in 70 iced tea glasses that have not exploded since December 1940 only because I do not have enough to set up the tables.

It will be necessary, until new glassware comes in, for all of us to drink milk from bottles with straws. I am sorry about this but did not anticipate this difficulty.

The soup bowls and dessert dishes have not exploded for over a year and seem completely safe to me. ~~If~~ the students are still concerned over these I will remove them.
