You may recall our conversation when you visited the Friends Center on Washington's Birthday. According to a note I made then, you will be returning to Bennington this Wednesday. I am planning to be in Vermont the week after next, and I wonder if it would be convenient for me to visit Bennington on Wednesday, ~~April 31~~. I am interested in talking with students who would like to take part in the summer volunteer projects of the AFSC, but I realize that not many of your students will be able to, since your term does not end until July 31st.
