

Dedications

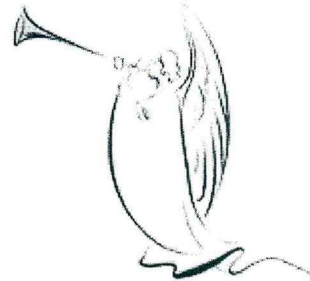
