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## LISTENING TO A FLUTE IN YELLOW CRANE PAVILLION

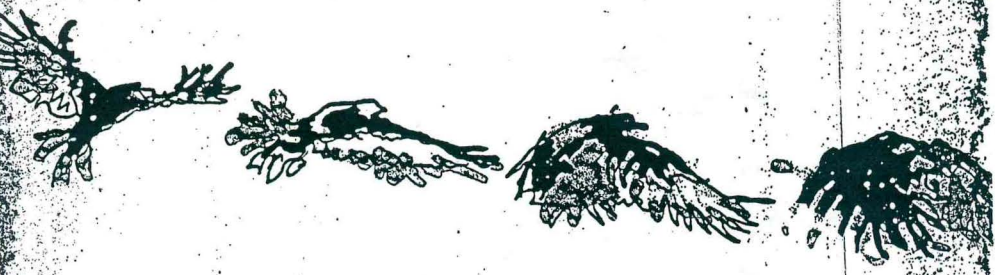
I came here a wanderer
