From L'incoronazione Di  
Poppea  
Poppea and Nerone sing a duet of love celebrating their victory over their foes and marvel at their triumph.

From Les Contes d'Hoffman

From Le Nozze di Figaro  
The Countess sings about how she longs for her husband's love and affection.

From Otello  
Desdemona aware of the threat to her life by her husband prays for herself and all of the unfortunates.
10. Adieu, Forets. By Peter Tschaikovsky  
From Jeanne d'Arc  
Joan of Arc makes the painful decision to leave her home and go off to battle as leader of the French army, a task that has been assigned to her by God.
