This is what she said: "I have been working to review prices and have found a number of items where pricing was able to be reduced. During the review, the price of many items available in the bookstore were found to be below suggested retail prices. Also, a comparison of prices was made to other local convenience and grocery stores as well to online vendors. On average, the Bennington College Bookstore prices are at, or below, the competition's pricing. To stay competitive, the retail price of all stock is now reviewed each time new inventory is received."
