On Thursday evening, June 19th, the Senior Projects of Jean Maggin and Dorothy Jayne Miller will be presented. Miss Maggin has been directly concerned with the problem of directing and has taken a scene from "Man and the Masses" by Ernst Toller as her subject matter for experimentation. "Into Gentle Hands" written by Dorothy Jayne Miller, who is also starring in the production, is a comedy built around the lines of a decadent Southern family.
