On the Monday afternoon a general meeting will be held. During this meeting there will be a presentation of the main issues conducted by special groups who will have made a study of the following topics:

- 1) Classes, curriculum and counseling
- 2) Co-education
- 3) Community Government
- 4) Philosophy of Bennington
- 5) Campus Living Conditions
- 6) The Role of the College in the Outside Community
