BENNINGTON, Vt. -- Ben Karp, a sculptor, will lecture on "Wood Motifs: The American Fantasy" Tuesday, November 8, at 8:00 p.m. in Commons Lounge at Bennington College.

There will also be a show of photographs by Mr. Karp in Commons Lounge. Both the photographs and the lecture are concerned with sawn wood ornamentation on the exteriors of Nineteenth-Century houses.

Mr. Karp teaches sculpture at the New York State University at New Paltz. He studied sculpture in France with Jo Davidson and Marek Szwarc, and has exhibited at the Metropolitan Museum of Art and the Museum of Modern Art in New York, the Pennsylvania Academy of Art and the Albany Institute of Art. He is represented in the collections of the Metropolitan Museum of Art, Brandeis University Art Museum, the Kalamazoo Institute of Art, the Montclair College Art Collection and private collections.

The exhibit of photographs will continue all week.
