Thousands of Chilean and foreign students have been arrested by the military junta which last week overthrew the Allende government. The governments of Argentina, Mexico, and Peru have let it be known to friends of the Chilean democracy that if American sentiment is strong they will open their doors to political refugees from among the student group. We urge you to send mailgrams and telegrams to the embassies of those three nations asking them to offer asylum to Chilean students and foreign political refugees whose lives are endangered by the junta and we ask you to tell friends and relatives throughout the country about this important and grave situation and to contact the embassies of Argentina, Mexico, and Peru as follows:
