They are protesting Harvard's investment in Gulf Oil Company, which actively supports the racist and exploitive regimes in Angola and Mozambique. We recognize that the liberation efforts here in America, in Vietnam, and in Africa are related in struggle against a common enemy.

The black students of Bennington have sent a telegram to the black students at Harvard-Radcliffe expressing support of their action. In light of the lack of attention given to the struggles of African peoples, we congratulate our Harvard-Radcliffe brothers and sisters.
