BENNINGTON, Vt. -- Marcelin Pleynet, the Director of Tel Quel, will speak on new movements in French literature Friday evening at 8:00 p.m. in the Carriage Barn at Bennington College.

Tel Quel, a French literary magazine founded in 1960, is edited by a group of young French writers whose original critical approach has led to the formation of a new literary movement (le groupe Tel Quel). The movement has been called, even by the most hostile critics, "the only important one since surrealism."

Pleynet is the author of three books of poems:

Provisoires Amants des Negres, Paysages en Deux, and Comme,
all of which are on exhibit in the College library.
