KEEP NIGERIA ONE

Having just returned from Nigeria after living there for three years and having been through two coup d'etats, I feel I can speak about the Civil War with slightly better insight than others. I think it a shame indeed that people with good intentions here at Bermington are being persuaded to support a cause that calls for the balkanization of Nigeria and the whole continent of Africa.

The East Central State of Nigeria known as Biafra does not solely consist of people belonging to the Ibo tribe. There are many, many people there belonging to minority tribes such as the Efik, Tbibio and Calabari. It is on their land that oil was discovered. It is in the minority tribe land regions that a large part of Nigerian resources is found. When the plan of secession was announced these minority tribes made it known throughout Nigeria that they were not to be a part of Biafra but instead to remain loyal to Nigeria. Following this announcement hundreds of Biafran soldiers marched on the villages of the Calabari people and slaughters took place too brutal and despicable to relate in a short galley. News straight from the front shows the Biafran atrocities and their ruthless supression of the minority tribes. Of course atrocities occur in any war but the Federal forces have taken extra precautions to keep unnecessary brutality at a minimum. Just last June two officers were publicly executed in Benin for damaging civilian property. But Biafran soldiers have practically destroyed the entire Calabar region, massacring whole villages.
