Hughie Lee-Smith, noted Afro-American artist, will give a slide lecture at Bennington College on 19th century Afro-American art, Tuesday, November 19, at 8:30 in Barn 1. The public is invited and there is no admission charge.

Mr. Lac-Smith studied at the Detroit Society of Arts and Crafts, the Cleveland Institute of Art and Wayne State University. He has won numerous awards, among them the Michigan Academy of Arts and Letters' Purchase Prize, 1956; the Emily Lowe Award, 1957; Mational Academy of Design, 1959, 1963; City Center, New York City, 1959; and the American Society of African Culture, 1960.

His work is included in many private collections and also in the collections of the Detroit Institute of Arts, Atlanta University, Lagos Museum, Lagos, Nigeria, and the University of Michigan.

The lecture is the fourth in a series sponsored by Bennington College's seminar on black culture.
