by the celebrated poet Galway Kinnell.

Galway Kinnell was Vermont's poet laureate from 1989 to 1993, and has been a recipient of a Guggenheim fellowship and a MacArthur "genius" grant. His first collection of selected poems won both the Pulitzer Prize and the National Book Award. For many years he was the Erich Maria Remarque Professor of Creative Writing at New York University. He is currently a chancellor of the Academy of American Poets.
