Proposed Curriculum for 1953-54

Basic Courses:

Six sections of Language and Literature will be conducted. This is the same number we have had this year. These classes will be taught by Mrs. Foster and Messrs. Belitt, Hyman, Kaplan, Wilcox, Nemerov and Golffing (with each of the latter two teaching one section for one term).

Mr. Fowlie will teach his Introduction to French Literature.

Language Courses:

The same number of courses in Spanish, French, German and Russian will be taught by Miss Hasenclever and Mrs. Montesinos. In addition Miss Hasenclever will teach two one term courses in German literature: The German Novel and German Drama of the Nineteenth Century. Mrs. Montesinos will teach a course entitled The Nineteenth Century Spanish Novel.
