Janet Frey read a memo from Mrs. Michaels regarding the behavior of Otis Kidwell's dog, which had damaged some pieces of College property.

Acting as Dog Registrar as decided by the meeting of May 12, the College Council voted unanimously to have Otis Kidwell's dog removed from the campus as soon as possible.

Janet Frey, the temporary chairman, and the other student members of the College Council agreed to meet with Otis in Franklin card room to discuss arrangements for the removal of the animal.

It was brought to the attention of the College Council that there is a misunderstanding regarding the proposed rule regarding dogs, under which animals are allowed to remain on campus the rest of the term. It was unanimously voted by the College Council that this rule stand as stated: "That she board her dog or cat off-campus at night".
