Dear Wendy,

Our letters must have crossed. I received your 'letter of intent' of 6/25 and your included order for 18 exhibition prints. I assume you received my letter of 6/22 along with WAAM loan contract and excerpts from WAAM catalogue. Hope they will be of some help.

To answer your last question first. Yes, I think I can have the exhibition prints to you by end of July as planned ... But, I will need balance of money for printing costs. \$160. I have received, to date, Bennington checks totaling \$200. toward printing costs.

This balance of \$160. should be sent immediately so that it can clear so that I can pay the printer in time. We have begun to print.

All contractual points that you list are agreeable to me. Regarding point 6, possible sales and percentages, whatever you guys think is fair and work out with the other photographers is all right with me.

Framing between two sheets of plexiglas also o.k. with me. Will plexi lie flush against print? Won't this damage photo?

Will let you know when I have received balance for printing costs from Bennington.
