

Report of Recreation Council Meeting-April 9th, 1940

At the Recreation Council meeting of April 9th, Miss Shelley, chairman of the Special Committee for the Recreation building, gave a brief summary of the work being done by this committee. The Special Committee has decided upon two definite regulations-concerning smoking and also the use of the game room floor. The committee has adopted several other policies to prevail from the opening of the building through the trial period. These concern the regular hours the building will be open; the plan of supervision; the branch store hours; furnishings; athletic equipment; the use of liquor in the building; and reservations. These policies are only tentative and are to be presented to the community for suggestion and approval. A full report from the Special Committee is to be read in house meetings.

The recreation building will be opened formally on Friday afternoon, April 12th at a tea given by the entertainment committee for the entire community. That night there will be a beer party in the building given by the entertainment committee. There will be a charge of 35¢ for refreshments which include beer and hot dogs.
