**Look up in the *online catalog* (on the **Crossett main search page**)**

CDs • by composer, subject, title, or keyword

Books • by author, title, subject

Scores • by composer, title, subject

## **Where are all these materials?**

### **FRONT ROOM**

#### **CDs**

in large drawers under the windows

#### **DVDs**

below a corner Faculty Reserve book case

#### **Miniature study scores**

near entrance door, alphabetical by composer

#### **Reference books**

on the mantle, and on the bookcase adjacent to circulation desk

#### **Circulating books**

on the front large shelves and call numbers “M - MT 70”

#### **Fake books and jazz vocals**

by the right end window

#### **Faculty reserve shelves**

3 different shelves/carts in the front room

#### **B.C. recordings of student and faculty concerts and workshops**

in date order on top of CD drawers and  
archival preservation project CDs in cabinet by the fireplace

### **SECOND ROOM**

Houses instrumental music and books MT - TK

### **THIRD ROOM “LISTENING ROOM”**

A/V equipment, full sized study scores,  
vocal music (Opera, Folk, Choral, Broadway)  
LP (Vinyl) Collection
