Dear Wendy and Dan,

Still no word from either of you since Wendy's print order-letter of intent of June 25.

My exhibition prints are ready to be shipped and have been since August 11. However, I will not ship them until I have received the following from you:

1. a formal contract with your signatures delineating ALL points previously discussed.
2. a written commitment stating that the loan fee of \$20. per print/\$200. minimum, will be sent to me as soon as final selection is made, and that the loan fee AND the unselected prints (if any) be sent to me PRIOR to the November '81 opening in Bennington.

In addition, I would like some assurance that the plexi frames WILL NOT BE flush against the prints. Also I would like to know the present state of the catalogue.

When I have received the above I will ship the prints UPS - to your address Wendy? Please confirm this also.

I can understand and appreciate the organizational difficulties involved in a project such as this, however, these contractual commitments must be finalized.

Looking forward to hearing from you so that I can wrap up my end.
