

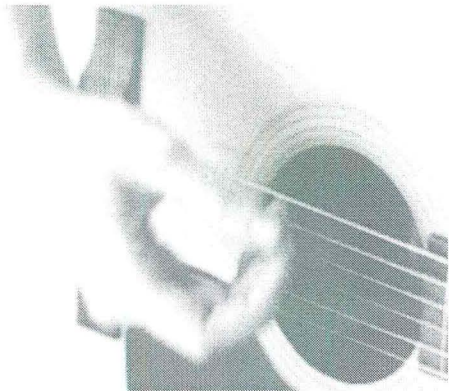

And thank you to all of you who have listened to my music over the years.

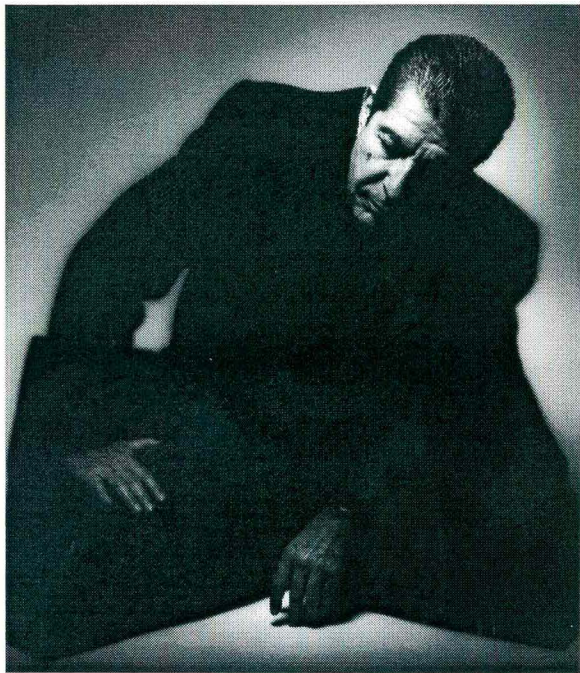

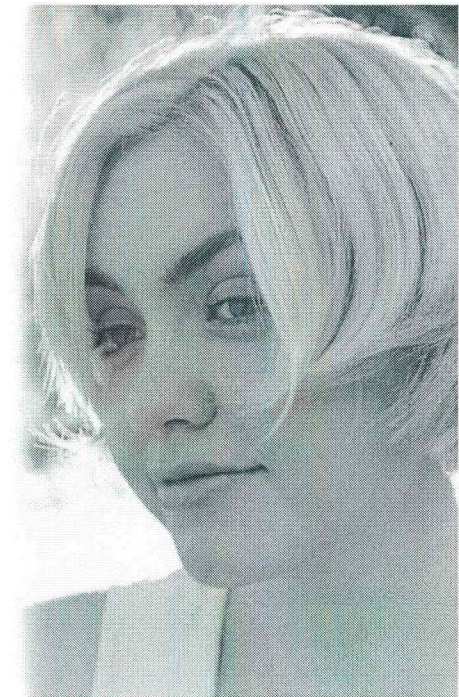
