Alfred Leslie will show and discuss his films in the Drama Department workshop, 4:30, Monday, April 8th, in Commons Theatre. Mr. Leslie is considered in some circles as the first independent underground film maker. He was the first recipient of the Film Culture Award and has received several festival prizes. His films have been shown commercially throughout the world.

Two of Mr. Leslie's paintings were exhibited in the Figurative Art Show here at Bennington last term. He has also had shows at the Whitney and other prominent museums and galleries.

Mr. Leslie has also worked as a scene designer Off-Broadway and has published a magazine called Hasty Papers.

Mr. Leslie will relate his work in history painting and in film making (which he regards as dated as electricity).
