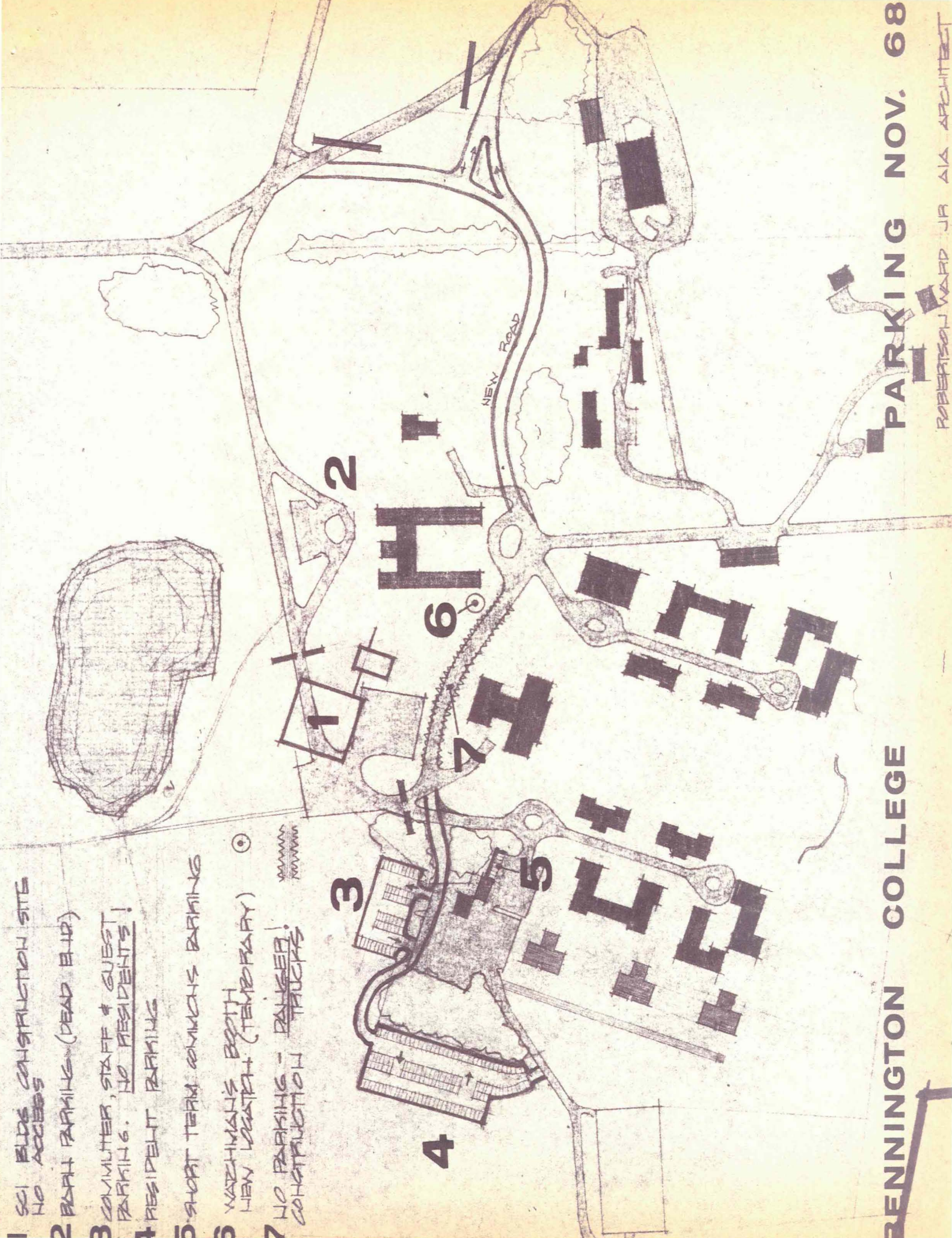

Subject: Parking Regulations

1. The following parking regulations are effective immediately:
 - a. Parking is prohibited on all College roads, except for ten minute parking on the lanes leading to student housing.
 - b. The Brick Garage Parking Lot, immediately north of the brick garage studios on the west side of campus (designated #3 on attached circulation map) is reserved for the use of faculty, staff and students who do not reside on campus.
 - c. The Tennis Court Parking Lot (designated #4 on the attached circulation map) is reserved for the use of faculty, students and staff who reside on campus.
 - d. The Barn parking lot is intended to be used primarily by faculty and staff who teach or work in the Barn and is available on a "first come, first served" basis.
 - e. Evening and weekend visitors to the campus may park in the Brick Garage Parking Lot or the Tennis Court Lot.
 - f. Short-term (20 minute) parking is available in the West Parking Lot, north of Leigh House (designated #5 on the attached map), for non-residents making a short visit to Commons. This parking is available as a substitute for parking in the Commons driveway which is prohibited.
2. We will shortly announce the availability of bumper parking stickers which will establish a right to the use of the above specified reserved parking spaces.
3. As the attached memorandum of the faculty and student Art and Architecture Committees makes clear, these regulations are necessary for the safety and convenience of the entire College community. We require the understanding cooperation of all to make them work.
