BENNINGTON, Vt. -- Lionel Rogosin will show his latest film "Good Times, Wonderful Times" and discuss documentary filmmaking Monday at 8 p.m. in the Commons Theatre at Bennington College.

The film won the Cineforum Award at the 1965 Venice Film Festival and first prize at the 1965 Leipzig Film Festival. The film has been described by Rogosin as "a tale of the assault on our sensibilities caused by the First World War, the Second World War and the people who will allow a third World War". It juxtaposes conversation by non-actors at a London cocktail party and actual footage taken from documentary films taken during the wars, and demonstrates, he says, "the indifference of people, the apathy, the drift, set in the context of how we live—and die."

Rogosin, an independent East Coast film producer and director, has also made "On The Bowery" and "Come Back Africa".
