BENNINGTON COLLEGE TO SHOW SELECTIONS FROM THE WILLIAMS COLLEGE MUSEUM OF ART

BENNINGTON, VT—"Material Matters: Selections from the Williams College Museum of Art" will open at Bennington College on Tuesday, October 20. An opening reception will be held from 6:00 to 8:00 p.m. in the Usdan Gallery, located in the Visual and Performing Arts Center on the Bennington College campus. The show will run through November 12. The Usdan Gallery is open from 1 to 5 p.m., Monday through Saturday, and the public is invited to attend free of charge.

The exhibit, organized by Linda Shearer, Director, Williams College Museum of Art, and Susan Imbriani, master's candidate in the Williams College Graduate Program in the History of Art, consists of approximately 20 works. Artists represented include Ida Applebroog, Lynda Benglis, Robert Morris, Louise Nevelson, Claes Oldenburg, Robert Rauschenberg, Edward Ruscha, and Robert Ryman, among others. The show focuses on large-scale, contemporary works from the Williams College collection and demonstrates the use of materials not traditionally associated with making art.
