

Report of Recreation Council Meeting -May 6, 1940.

It was announced at the Recreation Council meeting that on June 14th the Recreation Council will meet with the trustees to discuss the problem of athletic recreation at Bennington.

The Dance Committee announced that the formal dance will definitely be held in the Coach House this spring and because of the lack of furniture it will be possible to move furniture from the Commons for that purpose --which is an exception to the general policy.

Plans are being discussed concerning the activities of the Recreation Council next fall. It has been suggested that the Council change the system of dances next term and combine both the informal and the formal into one big weekend and have concerts, plays, or movies as added activities. This plan will be investigated and reported on in the next meeting.

The Council also discussed the pros and cons of repeating the sale of recreation tickets to cover all entertainments for next term. It is felt that this is not only a more convenient way of handling the situation but is an easier way to obtain the necessary funds needed ahead of time to have interesting and successful entertainments. The main objection to this plan is the fact that at the beginning of the year students are already overburdened with drives, subscriptions, and other expenses. Charlotte Watson, the student treasurer, will investigate the plan more thoroughly and report on it at the next meeting.
