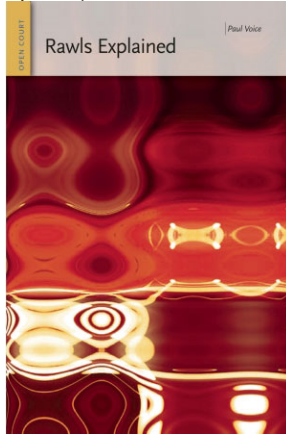


Faculty Member Paul Voice's New Book Examines Philosopher John Rawls
