Greenwall is still being used as one of the Dance Division's five spaces. We are about to undertake the restoration of the Dance space in the Maintenance warehouse, and when that is completed it will replace the dance space in the west brick garage, which will then be available for a somewhat more proper student union type building. I'm hopeful that we can then turn Barn 3-345 into a dance space that can then replace Greenwall in their curricular use. At that point Greenwall will once again be free, presumably for the Music Division but also for the various uses to which Christine hopes to put it.

Gunnar clearly has designs on the space. He is talking about wanting to turn it into "Harry Parch East". Parch, now deceased, used to have on the West Coast an elaborate establishment involving new instruments of his own design and creation,
