



Buildings, both old and new, have many of the original farm buildings, re-grace the campus. The original red barn still contains classrooms, faculty and administrative offices and the book store. North of the Barn lies Jennings meadow, and by way of a path one can arrive at the stone Jennings mansion. Both Jennings and the adjacent Carriage Barn serve as facilities for the Music and Black Music divisions.
