at the Joudour Sahara Music School



Located in the Sahara desert, in the town of M'Hamid El Ghizlane, this new music program will focus on preserving a valuable and ancestral cultural knowledge, and provide music education to the youth in a remote area of Morocco. Joudour Sahara is an ambitious project that includes the construction of facilities embedded in this beautiful natural environment. There are currently 20 students, ages 9-17, enrolled in the after-school program.

Possible projects include:

- · Teaching English,
- Teaching music (guitar, piano, percussion, singing, etc.),
- Archiving and recording music and video, and organizing and coordinating the library.

Requirements:

- Experience in French or Arabic
- Valid passport and visa (not applicable for US citizens)
- Applicants should be highly motivated and self directed. Musical experience is not required. Experience working with children is preferred.

Program cost:

Joudour Sahara will charge \$20 per day (discounted price) for housing and meals.
