In a sense, this piece is a conglomeration of all the elements of music that I've absorbed over the last three years through studying the saxophone, studying composition and listening a lot to the music of John Coltrane, Charlie Parker, Bill Dixon, Miles Davis, Carl Ruggles and others. And also, in a sense, this piece is an attempt to crystallize what I've learned. But at the same time, I hope it's neither one of these things.

A crystallization implies, to me, something hig, something important and a stopping point. To me, the piece isn't that at all. It's something I've wanted to try for a while and while not a stopping point, it is, maybe, a chance to collect myself musically. The piece is really no more or less than just a stop along the way.

Also, hopefully, it's not a conglomeration -- a mixture of different elements. Because in my mind, there are no diverse or opposing elements in this piece. For instance, the use of notation for some players in the piece is just a convenience so those players can play their parts easily. And the lack of notation for other players is just a convenience so they can play their parts easily. And it's obvious that these two methods and other seemingly opposing methods, instruments, or sounds are used to make the piece. But my hope was that it wouldn't sound like a mixture of elements but rather, one sound that I heard -- the sound of this piece of music.
