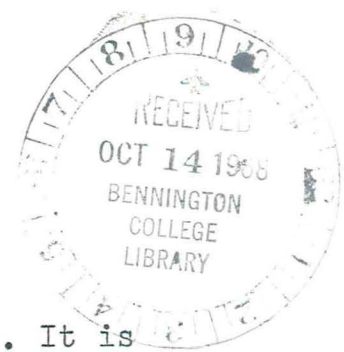

HELP KEEP BIAFRA ALIVE



A desperate situation exists in Biafra today. It is estimated that as many as ten thousand Biafran men, women, and children are dying a day. Five months ago, the death rate was 300 a day; in July the toll had risen to 6000 a day. With complete disregard for all humane principles, starvation is being used as a weapon of war. If relief does not come now, an entire population, 14 million people, may perish.

The people of Biafra need your help to feed their hungry and dying populace. They need your help to bring their case before the United Nations to seek a cease fire. They need your help to put pressure on Washington to use its influence in getting Britain to halt its supply of arms to the Nigerian government.
