The Educational Policies Committee met on Wednesday, September 25 at 6:30 o'clock in the Committee dining room. Present were Vida Ginsberg, Phoebe Arnold, Antoinette Larrabee, Sylvia Thayer, Elizabeth Plimpton, Mary Berna, and Margaret Dudley.

Procedures

The secretary reported that she has been making out a statement of the procedures and functions of the EPC for the Evaluation Study Committee on Community Government. In the course of this, she had noted an omission in the official "Procedures of Functions" pertaining to regular major meetings held by the EPC. It was agreed to include the following paragraph in the Procedures: The EPC shall hold major meetings in the Spring term with the students who are applying for admission to the Senior Division for discussion of the Senior Plan. Survey of Courses

The chairman appointed Antoinette Larrabee, Sylvia Thayer and herself as a committee to take charge of formulating the questionnaire for the annual survey of courses. It was agreed that the committee should consult with faculty members of their choice for suggestions about the questionnaire. The Social Studies representative said that she would submit some written suggestions arising from discussion of this subject in the Social Studies faculty meeting of September 25, 1940.
