## \*\*REMINDER\*\*

Dollar Brand, a South African jazz pianist, will perform a concert with his trio tonight at 8:00 p.m. in the Carriage Barn.

Brand is considered one of the foremost pianists and composers in South Africa, and has received great attention in Europe. He has had no formal training as a pianist or composer, and his music contains many diverse facets of South African music.

Brand came to this country in 1965 for a solo appearance at the Newport Festival, and had his New York debut with a concert in Carnegie Recital Hall in October 1965. He was also featured on the Museum of Modern Art Jazz series in 1966.

The other members of his trio are Calo Scott, a New York self-taught cellist, and Byard Lancaster, a saxophone, flute and clarinet player from Philadelphia.
