

Report of Recreation Council Meeting - Sept. 10th, 1940.

At the Recreation Council Meeting of Sept. 10th, Marjorie Hill was elected secretary of the council, and Lisa Adams was elected head of the Entertainment Committee.

There was a discussion of the possible added functions and responsibilities of the Recreation Council with regard to the national emergency. Such things as ways to raise money for the Red Cross; sponsoring Red Cross knitting, etc.; the increasing of physical education at college; and investigating the possibilities of a C.A.A. flying course were discussed. Nothing definite was decided upon but it was suggested that admission be charged for the informal dances (of which there will be several this Fall) in order to raise funds. It is possible that the Health Committee may be intending to sponsor Red Cross work, such as knitting. This will be investigated.

The Recreation Council had planned to sponsor several Sunday informal concerts by Mr. DeGray but these seem to be very indefinite and it was suggested that the Meetings Committee take over this idea.
