Judith serves on the Advisory Board of Climate Action Now and The Institute for Health and the Environment at the Albany School of Public Health. She is currently working on hurricane-related issues in the United States Virgin Islands and was appointed by the Governor to the USVI Hurricane and Resiliency Advisory Group.
