FOIBLE -- Woman to Lady Wishfort, accomplice of Mirabell . . .	Miss LeFevre
MINCING -- Woman to Mistress Millamant . . .	Miss Friedman
PEG -- Maid to Lady Wishfort . . .	Miss Sherwood
MIRABELL -- in love with Mistress Millamant . . .	Mr. Crowell
