AMENDMENT TO
ORGANIZATION OF
COMMUNITY

The following amendment to The Organization of the Bennington College Community was proposed:

G. The Community Chest Committee

1. The committee shall consist of two members of the community appointed by the Council during the second week in September.
2. The functions of the Community Chest Committee shall be:
 - a. To receive and evaluate all appeals for money made to the college community.
 - b. To manage the Employees' Christmas fund.
 - c. To draw up in November a budget to cover the appeals, which will be based on one annual contribution from each member of the community. The committee shall submit the budget to the Community Council for approval and post it on the bulletin boards.

A second amendment was proposed to re-word "c" as follows:

- c. To draw up in November a budget to cover the appeals, which will be based on voluntary contributions from the members of the Community. The committee shall submit the budget to the Community Council for approval and post it on the bulletin boards.

Both amendments were carried.
