


# The Argument + Plays

Based on Aristotle's Poetics and the essays of Gerald F. Else, **The Argument** dramatizes the attack on poetry made by Plato and the coherent rebuttal offered by Aristotle. A passionate student's love-letter and farewell to his teacher – reminding us of the personal pathos that binds us to the Greeks, and firing us to capture that chimera, art.

**Plays** is Gertrude Stein's witty and provocative lecture on theatre; a hidden gem of theatricality and wit that only Stein could have delivered – an account of her development as a playwright and her exploration of theatre from the standpoint of sight and sound.
