THE PRESENT STATE: The Present Faculty

1. Five full-time teachers
 - a. Director and Film teacher
 - b. Playwriting and Criticism Teacher
 - c. Design Teacher
2. Two Part-time teachers
 - a. Teacher of Acting 1
 - b. Teacher of Acting 2.
3. One and one-half full-time staff members
 - a. Technical Director
 - b. Film Assistant

THE ROTTEN STATE: Staff Proposals for Next Year

1. Three full-time teachers
 - a. One Acting teacher
 - b. One Directing teacher
 - c. One Criticism Teacher
2. One-half a staff member
 - a. One Technical Director

THE ENSUING RESOLUTION:

Since this arrangement would leave no faculty members available to teach Playwriting, Design, or Film, several Drama students have discussed the matter with President Bloustein and F.E.P.C. members. It was decided that another 1½ more faculty members would be hired, making a total of four full teachers, and two part-time teachers for next year.
